



Accessibility Guidelines & Resources

As part of AACCC's efforts to make the ATE Conference program accessible, we ask that you follow some general guidelines regarding the preparation and presentation of your ATE Connects submissions.

Preparation of Materials and Handouts

- Use simple fonts, such as sans serif (Arial, Calibri, Verdana, etc.) that are easy to read.
- Use high contrast easy to read colors.
- Avoid formatting text to overlap on any pictures or background images.
- Keep graphs and tables simple, and make sure they are legible and labelled.
